MISSION STATEMENT

It is our primary mission at Hearts Home Foundation to create and promote opportunities for women, children, and families, most of whom are low-income, so they can have safe and improved homes and their basic needs met. We also provide information, education, resources, networking, and support for women and children with a history of abuse and custody concerns.

OUR PRIMARY WORK

We renovate and build homes to develop private housing alternatives and provide various support resources for families in need. Housing vacancies and services are offered on a limited basis, per availability. We hope to expand our program to serve more families as we grow.

Families looking to relocate to a long term home and re-establish their lives after abuse will be given first priority. We maintain strict confidentiality of participant information, and a confidentiality agreement is required by participants who utilize this program.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Much of our work is in distribution of information and networking for mothers and their children, which is primarily done by Internet correspondence, web site postings, participation in surveys and statistic gathering, references, and support telephone calls. We also participate with our associate non-profit organizations, California Protective Parenting Association and Mothers of Lost Children, in our annual Child Sexual Abuse Awareness Conference, held in Davis, California.
